Group Project Fish or Insect Analysis

Each group project needs to contain the following:

1. **A Visual Display** which shows:
 - A title and the names of those in your group.
 - Your “critter” at its various stages (where applicable)
 - At least six “trivia” questions. They can be multiple choice or direct questions. The answers are to be placed at the bottom of the display with a paper taped over them (only tape the top so the paper can be lifted up).
 - Anything you may find handy when doing your oral presentation.

2. **An Oral Report.** You will need to show:

- Notes under four categories.
- Cue cards

You will also be marked on voice clarity, body language, content, use of visual aide(s) and use of the cue cards when giving the report.

3. **A Bibliography.** To acknowledge this website, put down www.kidfish.bc.ca If you use any additional materials add them to the list.

4. **A Plan.** In this plan you need to lay out what each person will do. Take advantage of each person’s strength. This plan must be shown to the teacher before you actually begin your work. As you work along, you may alter your plans if a better idea occurs.

Each group will be interviewed after the project is completed. Bonus marks may be given to anyone doing extra or marks may be taken away if a person doesn’t do their share. Observations will be made by the teacher as the project progresses. These notes will also influence your overall marks.
