Student Instructions for exploring the “Our Rivers” section of www.kidfish.bc.ca

- 1) connect to the internet and go to www.kidfish.bc.ca
- 2) Click on the “Our Rivers” icon
- 3) Find the phrase “The Fraser River Watershed Explained” (highlighted in blue). Click on it and find the answer to: By what city does the Fraser River start flowing south?

- 4) Click on “Back”. Scroll down until you find the heading “**What is a watershed?**”. Answer the question: What is a watershed ?

- 5) Scroll until you find the phrase “**Interesting Facts About the Fraser River**” (highlighted in blue). Click on it and find the answer to: What country would fit into the Fraser River watershed?

- 6) Scroll until you see “**Properties of Rivers**”. Answer the following: What are “young” rivers like?

- 7) Scroll down (a lot!) until you see “Click here to get some information on studying a stream”. Answer the following: What job do shredders do?

- 8) Click on “Back”. Find “More Interesting facts about the Fraser River Basin”. Click on it, then answer the following: How many snow geese use the Fraser River Basin?

- 9) Click on “Back”. Scroll down until you reach “And more Interesting facts about the Fraser River”. Click on it and answer: How many people make this watershed their home?

- 10) Click on “Back”. Below the heading “**Dams and Electricity**”, you’ll see “**Click here to see more about the effects of dams on rivers**”. Click on it and describe what is contained in this link.
